

The Assyrian Children's Illustrated Dictionary book has two covers, one reading from right for the alphabet (which I call the front cover), and the other reading from left for the numbers (which I call the back cover). If you want to print and bind the book, please note that all the odd pages are on the right and all the even pages are on the left. For example pages iii and iv will be facing each other; thus: [iv, iii], pages 1 and 2 will be facing each other; thus: [2,1] and pages 3 and 4 will face each other; thus [4,3], etc. The comma in [4,3] stands for the middle of the book where it is bound. Page i is blank and it is the back of the front cover with the alphabet. And page 260 is blank and it is the back of the back cover with the numbers.
